■ Direct Entry Into BA(Hons) Level 1 Programme

- 2 Principals STPM/'A' Levels with 2 credits or equivalent or
- 5 Credits SPM/UEC/'O' Levels or equivalent and
- Pass TOA Foundation in Communication Design or pass in relevant Foundation Programme from a recognised institution of higher learning

- IELTS score of 6.0
- A portfolio demonstrating drawing ability and graphic design/multimedia design skills (i.e. produce any artworks done in your previous recognised institution)

■ **Direct Entry Into BA(Hons) Level 2 Programme**

- 2 Principals STPM/'A' Levels with 2 credits or equivalent or
- 5 Credits SPM/UEC/'O' Levels or equivalent and
- Pass The One Academy Diploma Programme or a recognised institution of higher learning relevant diploma in the field
- IELTS score of 6.0
- Demonstrate good academic writing skills (i.e. produce any academic writing assignments/essays done in your previous recognised institution)
- A portfolio demonstrating drawing ability and graphic design/multimedia design skills (i.e. produce any artworks done in your previous recognised institution)

■ **English Language Requirements**

Proficiency in spoken and written English is fundamental to your success at The One Academy. All applicants are required to take for an English Placement Test (EPT) prior to admission to the course of study set by The One Academy. The English Placement Test is to assess your proficiency level. Applicants who do not meet our minimum English requirement will be required to undergo into the Intensive English Programme (IEP) offered by The One Academy for a semester before commencing the normal academic programme.

■ **Exemptions**

An exemption from a subject/module will be granted only on the basis of prior study at a recognised institution of higher learning and students can demonstrate that they have acquired all the skills and knowledge described by the learning outcomes of the subject/module.

Application for Subject/module Exemption upon admission should be a one-off exercise. No subsequent exemptions will be approved during the course of study except for newly gained qualifications after admission.

To apply for subject/module exemptions:

- Completed application for Subject/module Exemption
- Certified true copies of relevant certificate(s)
- Certified true copies of the academic transcripts including grading system
- Certified true copies of the subject outlines/syllabuses
- Portfolios demonstrating the work and study undertaken in previous recognised institution

Applications for Subject/module Exemption will not be considered for any subject that a student has previously attempted and failed.

If required, student will be ask to

- Sit for proficiency test(s)
- Qualifying examination(s) prior to the granting subject/module exemption.

■ Application Procedure

Complete and submit the Course Application Form together with the required supporting documents below:

- a. A completed Course Application Form.
- b. Certified true copies of academic results relevant to entry requirements. Forecast results are accepted for students applying for January intake.
- c. A certified true copy of School Leaving Certificate. (If any)
- d. 4 (Four) recent passport-size coloured photographs with your name written on the reverse. (One to be pasted on the top right hand corner of your application form)
- e. A photocopy of the Identity Card.(IC)
- f. Exemptions - supporting documents. (If requested)
- g. Certificate true copy sponsorship/scholarship letter and documents. (If applicable)
- h. Portfolio comprises of
 - i. One landscape still-life composition (colour drawing, any size)
 - ii. One free composition (any media, any size)
- i. A non-refundable and non-transferable registration fee and tuition deposit of RM1000 can be made by personal cheque to **The One Academy of Communication Design Sdn Bhd.**

Note: Please DO NOT send in cash for security reasons. The registration fee and tuition deposit must be received before your admission application is being processed.

■ Providing False Information

The qualifications stated in your Application Form will be verified by checking the original documents at the time of enrolment. Providing false or misleading information or failure in supplying the required documents will lead to disqualification of the application. Fees paid will NOT be refunded.

■ Application Acknowledgement

The applicant will receive an application acknowledgement via e-mail after the Registration Office has received your completed Application Form.

If you have not received an acknowledgement after 14 working days from the submission date, please contact the Registration Office.

■ Application Result Notification

The One Academy will approve an application based on the qualifications stated in the Application Form. Additional information provided after the approval process will only be considered if time permits, at the discretion of the relevant department/school.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS(FAQs)

■ How is my application being processed?

Once your application form is received, it will be sent for evaluation. The One Academy will confirm your eligibility within 14 working days.

- Successful applicants will receive the offer letter, offer Response Form, Conditions of Enrolment and Fees Payment Form by post.
- Unsuccessful applicants will also be notified in writing. Your portfolio and tuition deposit (RM700) will be returned.

■ Do I need to sit for an English Placement Test?

Yes. It is compulsory for every student to sit for an English Placement test as ruled by The One Academy.

The English Placement Test is to assess your language proficiency level. It will be scheduled once the student reports to Registration Office. If the student does not meet the minimum English requirement, the student will be required to enrol into The One Academy's Intensive English Programme (IEP) before joining the normal academic programme.

■ How much are my tuition fees and other payments?

Details regarding tuition fees are attached together with the Application Form.

The successful applicant is required to settle the First Semester's payment in full to the college within the date stipulated in the Offer Letter. Payment should be made via cheque or bank draft payable to:

■ Do I need to attend The One Academy's Induction Programme?

Yes, it is compulsory for new students to attend the Induction Programme before class commences. You will be briefed on the essential skills, comprehensive information about your timetable and other information relevant to your studies.
